The UHCC Strategic Directions 2015-2021 developed a baseline and aspirational targets for Degrees and Certificates combined. To comply with changes to the 2019 Annual Report, the UHCC Office for the Vice-President of Community Colleges, with input from campus IRs and CAOs, decided to calculate "degrees only" and "certificates only" using the same methodology that was used to develop baseline and aspirational targets for "degrees and certificates combined." The methodology was to use a three-year average for fiscal years 2013-2015 for the baseline year, with an aspirational value of 5% growth per year from the baseline year.

USDE official cohort Student Loan Default Rate (FSLD) was rounded up on the Annual Fiscal Report because the form would not take decimals.
