Kaua'i Pride Parade & Festival promotes and celebrates peace, acceptance, and unity for everyone on our island regardless of sexual orientation, gender identity, race, ethnicity, religious affiliation, or background. Our first annual Pride Parade and Festival was held in June 2019.

This year, in 2022, we are excited and proud to announce our first academic scholarship.

### **ELIGIBILITY**

Applicants should demonstrate a strong connection to the LGBTQIA+ community.

This award is to be used by individuals furthering their education through university, college, technical/vocational school, or other post-secondary programs. The award must be used during the 2022-2023 academic year.

Applicants must live on Kaua'i.

One award will be reserved for graduating seniors. One award will be open to applicants of all ages.
