As a member of the University faculty and Responsible Employee, I am required to immediately report any incident of sex discrimination or gender-based violence to the campus Title IX Coordinator. Although the Title IX Coordinators, and I cannot guarantee confidentiality, you will still have options about how your case will be handled.
